We regret that we are unable to fill your request for germplasm. It is the National Germplasm System (NPGS) policy to provide small quantities of available germplasm to research and educational institutions for research, testing, and scientific breeding that require genetic diversity or specific genetic standards.

There are possible alternative sources for fulfilling your needs for this or similar germplasm. One website, Plant Information Online, operated by the University of Minnesota (<http://plantinfo.umn.edu/default.asp>), enables searches for numerous diverse cultivars. Many of the most popular samples in the NPGS. "Clicking" on the name of a cultivar will provide a list of commercial nurseries that can provide plants.

State Cooperative Extension Systems, often administered through the State Land Grant Universities, can provide abundant information on crops and cultivars adapted to your area and information on those that have not proven successful there. Other sources of horticultural and gardening information for your locale include Master Gardener organizations, gardening clubs, public gardens, and local plant nurseries and garden centers.

Please note that the preceding information does not constitute an endorsement of any product or supplier by the U.S. Department of Agriculture or cooperating agencies.

If you believe that you have received this letter in error, please provide additional information regarding the planned use for the requested germplasm. Explain specifically why the requested germplasm is required for that use, rather than adapted, commercially available cultivars.
